

A few more HTML tips for posting on the forum

This will put a 2 pixel black border around your picture

```

```

Change 2 to whatever size border you want, 0 if you want no border, replace the URL in red to the URL of your image file

This will make your image a link to another page on the web

```
<a href="http://www.anysite.com/index.htm">  
 alt="[Click to visit]"  
</a>
```

Can all be on one line, no spaces. Change blue text to the URL of the page you want to link to. Green text is the text that comes up in a little box next to your pointer when it is over the image (can be left blank). If you use a border it will be the same colour as links on the page (default is blue)

To create a text link

```
<a href="http://www.anysite.com/index.htm">Click Here</a>
```

Change blue text to the URL of the page you want to link to. Red text is the visible text that you click on.

To make text bold, or even just part of your text

```
<b>my text</b>
```

The above are basic examples of HTML you may wish to use when posting on a forum, just include them as part of your message.

Eg: To visit my dog's web page [Click Here](http://www.anysite.com/index.htm) I hope you like it.
